- Embrace change to continually improve




Our History

Located in downtown Foxboro, across from the library and a block from the town common, shops and restaurants, The Doolittle Home is part of a vibrant community.




The Doolittle Home is a nonprofit organization. We are privately and independently managed by a volunteer Board of Trustees from the area and the industry.

The Doolittle Home is unique. We have history. Reminiscent of a New England Bed and Breakfast, our historical residence offers both gracious appointments and supportive nursing care. In a time when bigger is better, we are small and focused. Where other places are buildings, we are a home. When it comes to resident care, our reputation is exceptional. The Doolittle Home offers private rooms in our residential home and our all-inclusive services include:

- Medication management
- Pharmacy services
- 24/7 Supportive nursing care as needed
- Nurse call service in every room
- 3 Delicious, home-cooked meals daily
- Access to snacks and beverages at all times
- Personal care services
- Daily in-house laundry and ironing
- Daily housekeeping and linen services
- Daily activities and exercise program
- 3 outdoor porches and a manicured park
- Weekly hairdressing/barber services
- On-site doctor visits
- Physical, occupational and speech therapy
- Dietician-directed individual dietary plans
- Transportation to local medical appointments



The Doolittle Home offers different entry options to meet the varying needs of our residents.

Life Care Plan

A hallmark plan offered for over 100 years, Life Care ensures care for the resident for life, regardless of changes in health or financial status. Life Care residents pay an upfront fee that takes into account recurring income, such as social security, a pension, investment dividends, etc. and the age at admission. As health changes dictate, residents may receive supportive nursing care at no additional cost to the family.

Residency Plan

Seniors seeking assisted living may enter the home for a monthly fee. Seniors enjoy the all-inclusive services in addition to a private, comfortable room. Under this plan, residents remain at The Doolittle Home as long as their health and finances allow. If full-time nursing care becomes necessary, access is available for an additional fee.

Respite Care

The full amenities of the home are available with a minimum one-week stay. Month-long and winter stays are also available. Respite stays provide caregivers a needed break or opportunity to go away knowing that their loved one is being cared for by our dedicated staff. A respite stay is also a great opportunity for a senior to sample life at The Doolittle Home and make a later transition more easily.
